




## **Highlights**


- 1. Offered a Farmers Market that provided over \$1,000 FREE produce for participants

- 6. Distributed Summer Fest Tray cards for all SFGH inpatients


## **Summer Fest Participants**

We welcomed over 800 participants, comprised of SFGH patients, Staff, and community members during Summer Fest 2014. During the event, three volunteers administered surveys to a random sample size of Summer Fest participants. We surveyed a sample size of 111 participants of which 55 were SFGH staff and 56 were Community Members/Patients.

All community partners who held a booth at Summer Fest were asked to complete a *Community Partner Participation Survey* via web or via hard copy at the event. We received 15 surveys back from our community partners. Some of the results are as following:

- 93% rated the fair as Excellent
- 93% reported they would like to participate in the following festival
- Partners reported, on average about 88 participants visited their booth.
- 100% responded that we provided adequate information to successful plan their community booth
- Partners recommended to invite participants such as; SF Bike Coalition, SF Health Plan, Homeless Prenatal Program, The NABE at Potrero Hill, and CARCEN to next year's festival.

Our community partners provided us with the following feedback:

- "You all did a really great [job] organizing this event. Everyone seemed to be enjoying themselves; I would love to come to any future festivals or programs."
- "I know the room was packed, but infomercial stars making substantiating claims may not be appropriate. The music was too loud, making it difficult to give advice to people. Great giveaways; healthy food samples. Well organized. Congratulations to the organizing committee!"
- "My booth is too close to the DJ, music was too loud which makes communicating a big challenge especially when we are providing free phones to hard of hearing folks. would like to be placed further away from the DJ next year if possible."
- "This event was truly inspirational. I feel so honored to have been a part of it. Thank you so much for the good work you all do at the CWP!"
